A Transfer Equivalency Report (TER) that shows AP or IB credit or Language Placement Test(s) will *not* list an institution here. Every institution attended by a student generates a separate TER, so any other transfer credit the student may have earned will appear separately.

The "course" listed here is actually the result of a Language Placement Test. It appears on the Academic Evaluation so the computer system knows to let the student into any classes for which the equivalent courses are prerequisites. No credits are awarded for Language Placement Test results.

The "Credits" column lists the credits Whitman awards for each course. Here, two numbers are listed because IB Physics counts as equivalent to two Whitman physics courses.

The maximum limit for combined AP and IB credit is 30 credits. Since this student has earned more than 30 credits, they cannot receive credit for everything, and some credits must be removed. The removed credits are indicated by an "N" in the "Stat" column and "PR" in the "Status" column (standing for Notational and Preliminary, respectively).

This means the course will not appear on the Academic Evaluation or Transcript, but has been entered into the computer system for record-keeping. If a student with more than 30 credits wishes to change which course is not counted, they should make this request at the Registrar's Office.

Each group of rows lists one course (the blue brackets here show these delineations). The "Score" column only appears for AP and IB credit and Language Placement Tests. It lists the student's score on each test. The "Stat" column only appears for AP and IB credit and Language Placement Tests. An "A" here indicates Accepted credit. An "N" indicates Notational credit (courses we keep track of for our records, but which do not count toward the Whitman degree).

Typically N's only appear if the student took enough courses to exceed the 30 credit AP/IB limit, or if we have not yet received an official score report. The "Course/Subject/Crs Lvl" column shows how each course transferred. The transfer equivalency codes listed here will appear on the Academic Evaluation.

AP and IB credit appear with the ".HS" code at the end of the transfer equivalency. This code indicates the credits were completed in High School and were not earned through college courses. The total credits applicable from this category (AP and IB credit).

This total does not subtract any credits marked as Notational/Preliminary, so be sure to check for any such markings, as these courses will not appear on the Academic Evaluation or Transcript.
