

English Major + Creative Writing Minor

Students who combine a major in English and a minor in Creative Writing will be allowed to use one creative writing and one literature course to satisfy both sets of requirements. Students, in this case, will complete a minimum of 48 credits total. Otherwise, no course may satisfy more than one requirement.
