I'm not Resistance. I'm not a hero. I'm a stormtrooper. Like all of them, I was taken from a family I'll never know. And raised to do one thing. But my first battle, I made a choice. I wasn't gonna kill for them.

I often think back to my first waking moments, trying to recall fleeting childhood episodes that have since escaped my memory. What was my father like? My mother? Am I sure that my parents raised me, or that they existed at all? Most days, the memories are filled with an endless sea of stormtroopers that I became a mindless member of. Surely the others I trained with day in and day out must be equally curious about their origins. After all, one's mind can't help but wander when each and every lesson, exercise, mission, centers around the embrace of two principal behaviors: loyalty and obedience.

I cannot truthfully say that the notion of defiance has always been at the forefront of my mind. When it comes to serving the First Order, one only knows one way of life. Each day mirrors the one before, each command unflinchingly rigid as the next. Simply put, one has no time, nor the authority, to question the larger purpose of our actions. We simply fall in line, execute the directive, and repeat without question.
