Reflect on a time when you questioned or challenged a belief or idea. What prompted your thinking? What was the outcome?

Let the past die. Kill it, if you have to. That's the only way to become what you are meant to be.

In my years of intense study of the Force, both under the Jedi and the First Order, I've been forced to reflect on my past. I come from a long line of leaders of our galaxy - my uncle Luke Skywalker, my father Han Solo, and my mother Princess Leia led the fight against the Empire. Growing up, I was raised in the cradle of their beliefs and morals. I was taught that all they did for our galaxy was good, but I've now learned that there are two sides to every story.
