NEW BUSINESS

• Safety Concerns:

Steve Davis reports that the Handicap parking, adjacent to the Welty Health Center, needs to be repainted. John Hopkins asked Steve to submit a work order to Facilities, and reiterated that it is management's responsibility to make sure employees don't park in handicap zones which are ticketed by the city police.

- Review of college's *On the Job Accident Prevention Program, Appendix 4 First Aid Plan* <u>https://www.whitman.edu/environmental-health-and-safety/safety-and-environmental-programs/on-the-job/accident-prevention-program/appendix-4-%E2%80%93-first-aid-plan</u> Comments and observations:
 - The second paragraph states First Aid Kits are available at locations throughout campus. Several committee members mentioned that current building maps don't show location of AED and First-Aid kits. However, Jolene Rodriguez says the Welty Health Center has a campus map showing locations (attached) so that information can be added to building maps. Nikki is visiting offices around campus and plans to purchase First Aid decals to post for easy location of kits. Nikki has noticed that some kits are expired, and is actively working with building staff to get this remedied.
 - The third bullet point of appendix looks incomplete, "If medical assistance is required". Needs editing. Wording suggested: "If you choose to provide medical assistance ..." and finish sentence or update bullet points appropriately.
 - > The appendix' bullet points need to be revised to clarify what each person is (the person that was hurt or the person administering first aid). Nikki will work with Fred to rewrite for clarity.
 - First Aid/CPR training is offered by the college but not regularly advertised. Nikki Young is the contact person who is currently working to be certified as First Aid trainer. Steve Davis is working with Nikki to get all Security staff CPR/First Aid/AED certified.
 - In addition to calling 911, college security and/or the Welty Health Center should be contacted.
- Nikki Young reports that one employee had a minor hand injury since our last meeting. The hand injury did not require medical attention.


